

STUDIO DRESS CODE

To get the most out of each dance class, we believe students **MUST** dress the part of a dancer.

Please see the dress code requirements below for each class.

****For safety reasons and dance discipline, students who are not dressed properly for class will be asked to sit and watch (i.e, t-shirt, socks and shorts for Ballet w/o shoes)**

INTRO TO DANCE, BEGINNING TAP/BALLET and ELEMENTARY DANCE:

- Leotard, any style or color, **WITHOUT** skirts
- Tights, any style or color
- PINK Ballet Shoes (pink required for recital, other colors ok for class)
- TAN Tap Shoes with Buckles (Purchased through Studio Store)
- INTRO students...Ballet Shoes only
- BEGINNING/ELEMENTARY students....Ballet and Tap Shoes needed
- Hair should be pulled up and away from face for each class

LEVELED/COMBINATION CLASSES:

- Leotard, any style or color
- Tights, any style or color
- All levels, PINK Ballet Shoes (pink required for recital, other colors ok for class)
- TAN or BLACK Tap Shoes (Verify Color/Style with Studio Director)
- TAN or BLACK Jazz Shoes (Required for certain levels. Verify Color/Style with Studio Director)

INDIVIDUALIZED TECHNIQUE CLASSES (Beg, Int and Adv Levels)

BALLET (very strict dress code applies-NO EXCEPTIONS)

- Black Leotard
- Pink Tights (free of holes and runs. Footed or Convertible. **NO** Footless)
- PINK Split Sole Ballet Shoes
- Hair in Ballet Bun, securely fastened with Bobby Pins and Hair Net
- PLEASE NOTE: Ballet students not 100% dressed properly (including Hair) will **NOT** be allowed to participate in class.

JAZZ, TAP and MODERN:

- Appropriate Leotards & Tights ONLY. NO jazz pants, crop tops, t-shirts or shorts...NO EXCEPTIONS
- Hair must be pulled up and away from face
- BLACK or TAN Jazz Shoes (Verify Color/Style with Studio Director)
- BLACK or TAN Tap Shoes (Verify Color/Style with Studio Director)
- Modern Students: generally dance barefoot, however, Dance Paws are acceptable (tan or nude required for recital)

HIP HOP:*the only style we offer that DOES NOT have a specific dress code

- Jazz pants, sweat pants, t-shirts acceptable
- NO Shorts due to floor work in class
- NO Jeans as movement is restricted
- Hair must be pulled up and away from face
- INTRO / MINI Students: Black slip on jazz shoes—NO STREET SHOES
- All other levels: Black lace up dance sneakers—NO STREET SHOES
- PLEASE NOTE: Due to the nature of some moves performed in Hip Hop, students are NOT ALLOWED to dance barefoot.
